WARNING:

- To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock, injury or damage to your machine please adhere to the following warnings:
- Always keep the SpaVac's Battery Compartment Cap firmly closed during operation to prevent water from entering the tube. Water entering this chamber will ruin the electronic components of your unit.
- Never leave your SpaVac in the water when it is not running.
- The cleaner is designed for underwater applications ONLY, and should be submerged during use.
- Do not attempt to use this cleaner to clean anything other than your hot tub or spa. It should not be used as an all-purpose vacuum cleaner.
- This vacuum creates suction under water and therefore hair, loose clothing, fingers, and other parts of the body should be kept away from openings and moving parts at all times.
- Store your cleaner in a clean, dry place, out of direct sunlight and away from extreme temperatures.
- Avoid picking up hard, sharp objects with the vacuum, as it may cause damage to the inner filter surface.
- Do not use to pick up toxic, flammable, or combustible substances, or operate in the presence of explosive or flammable fumes.
- Never forcibly insert objects into the unit.
- Make sure the vacuum is off before cleaning the unit.
- If vacuum cleaner is not working as it should, or has been dropped or damaged in any way, return it to a service center before using. To find the repair center nearest you, go to www.poolblaster.com or call us toll free at 1-800-298-8800.

Water Tech Corp warrants this product for 90 days against any defects in material or workmanship. The defective product will be repaired or replaced at no charge in either of two ways.

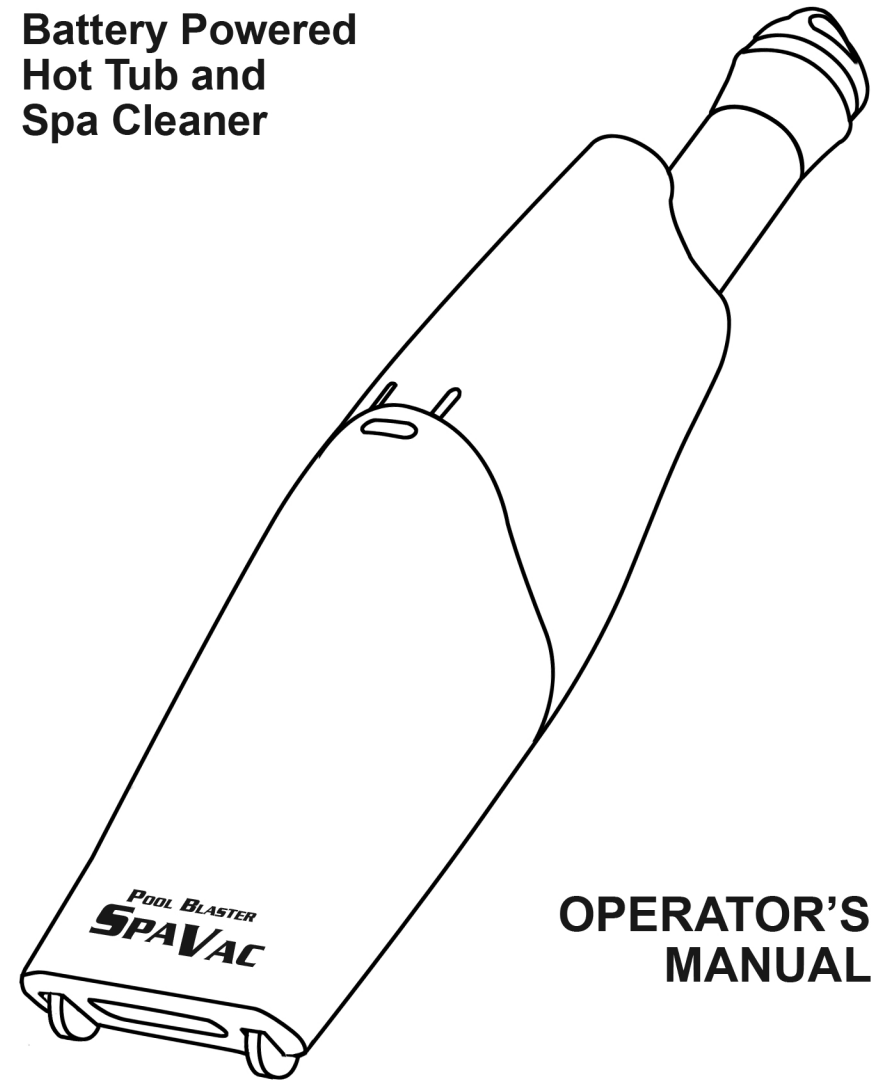

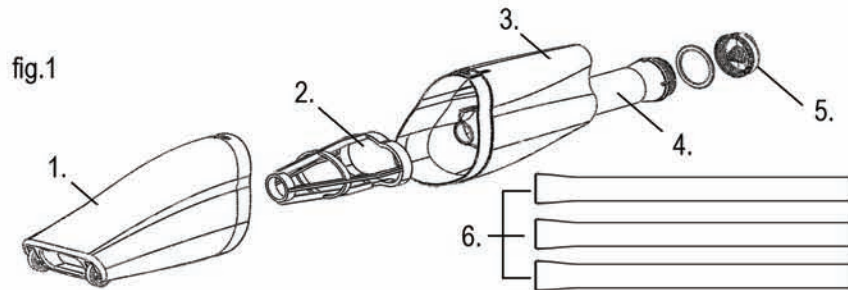

Getting to Know Your SpaVac

Your SpaVac consists of six main parts: (1)the Nose Cap, (2) the Filter/ Filter Frame, (3)the Main Body, (4)the Battery Compartment, (5)the Battery Compartment Cap, and (6)the Segmented Pole [fig. 1].



The unit can be easily disassembled into its component parts by first unscrewing the Battery Compartment Cap and pressing on the top of the Main Body section of the unit where it meets the Nose Cap and gently pulling apart [see fig. 4]. The Kiddie Pool Broom is powered by 3 C-Cell batteries (Not Included)

Basic Usage

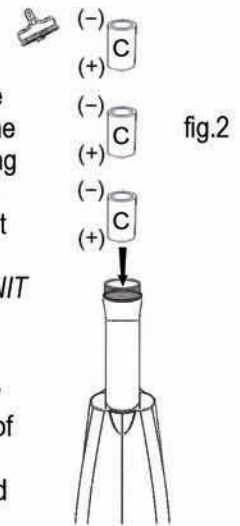
YOUR SPAVAC IS NOT INTENDED FOR USE SWIMMING POOLS.

The SpaVac has been designed for cleaning hot tubs and spas only. USING YOUR SPAVAC FOR UNINTENDED USES MAY RESULT IN DAMAGE TO THE CLEANER AND WILL VOID YOUR WARRANTY.

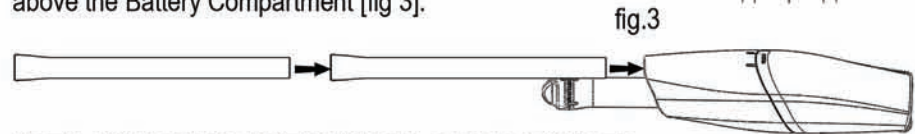
Set up

Setting up the SpaVac is easy and quick. Simply unscrew the Battery Compartment Cap and insert 3 C-Cell batteries into the Battery Compartment with the positive end of the battery facing into the tube [fig 2]. Replace the Tube Cap and close the unit until the indicator marks on the Cap and Battery Compartment are aligned. This should activate the unit.

IF THE BATTERIES ARE INSTALLED INCORRECTLY, THE UNIT WILL NOT FUNCTION.



If using the included pole, simply attach the pole segments by pressing the straight end of one segment into the flaired end of another segment. Once the pole has been assembled to the desired length, it can be inserted into the pole receiver located above the Battery Compartment [fig 3].

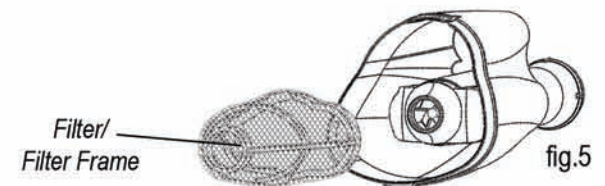
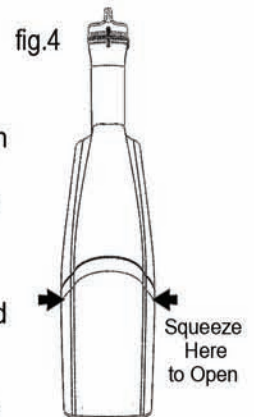


NOTE: THE POLE IS NOT INTENDED OR DESIGNED TO SUPPORT WEIGHT AND CANNOT BE LEANED ON.

Maintenance and Storage

We recommend that you clean out the SpaVac after each use. The Nose Cap can be easily removed by gently squeezing the Nose Cap as indicated [fig. 4]. Shake debris out of the Cap. Then remove the Filter and Filter Frame by rocking it side to side and pulling gently [fig. 5]. Once removed rinse the filter under a tap or garden hose to clean it and then re-install it in the Main body by pushing it gently into place.

The SpaVac's Nose Cap and Filter can be washed using soap and water. Any contact with solvents or other substances like brake fluids, gasoline, petroleum-based products, penetrating oils, and the like should be avoided at all times as it may cause irreparable damage to the unit.



The SpaVac should be stored indoors in a clean, dry location, sheltered from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and rain. Always remove the batteries when storing the SpaVac for extended periods of time. To keep your SpaVac working like new for seasons to come, clean the seals in the main motor tube.
